



**The Front Weymouth Skatepark
RAMP REFURBISHMENT FUND
Sat 10th APRIL 9.00pm – Sun 11 APRILth 9.00am**

This year's all night skate is taking place to raise money for the much needed ramp refurbishments at The Front. The All Night Skate is a sponsored event that has been extremely successful in the past and this time round we aim to make it bigger and better, with jam competitions for excellent prizes, pro demos and fun activities. The emphasis is for this all night skate to be a fun and safe event not an endurance test.

Participant information

- The All Night Skate is run in the same fashion as a regular skate park session (but lasts 12hrs), with addition of fun comps, bbq and activities
- At least one member of the Skatepark Management team will be on duty throughout the event and at least two first aid workers at all times.
- Everyone is welcome to take part! (under 8's must accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times)
- U16 taking part must bring the parental consent form from the bottom of this letter in order to take part in the event.
- There will be space for all participants to sleep, so bring your sleeping bag and pillow
- There will be hot food on offer through the night as well as the usual snack bar facilities
- There will be other activities throughout the evening including films and skate DVD's played on a large projector screen!!
- Anyone can leave at any time and there are phones available to contact parents etc.
- You will not be able to come and go from the skatepark over night, if you are in the event you must stay at the skatepark.

How to take part

1/ Collect or download an Official Sponsorship form and raise sponsorship money (**as much as you can**). As you are raising money for the skatepark you will have FREE ACCESS to the All Night Skate. ***Money must be given to the skatepark on the night of the event** in order to gain free access. ***You must also raise a minimum of £15.00 sponsorship.**

2/ Pay **£15.00** on the door on the night of the event.

Spectators

Spectators are welcome and anyone who is not intending to use the ramps but would still like to enjoy the All Night Skate can turn up on the evening pay **£10** and stay all night.

Rules & Regs

All staff have been briefed to do all they can to ensure the event causes no nuisance to anyone beyond Skatepark itself. All Skatepark rules, regulations and procedures will continue to apply, and the staff have the power to adapt or curtail the event if necessary, or disqualify any participant for inappropriate behaviour.

- All Participants will have to be registered, and under-16s must have a signed parent-consent form.
- As with all Skatepark sessions there is a zero tolerance policy for the consumption of alcohol or drugs and the use of offensive language.
- Helmets must be worn at all times when using the ramps
- Participants must behave responsibly at all times and treat one another with due care and respect
- Participants may NOT come and go as they please, once you have left the premises you will not be allowed back.

With regards to collection of sponsorship money, we would ask you to bring all donations into the skatepark on the night of the event in order to gain free access.
